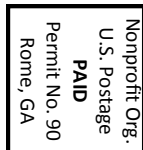

Even though it falls under the umbrella of Men's Ministry, this year's Sportsmen's Banquet will provide opportunities for you to participate in a variety of ways, from sponsoring tables, to promotion of the event, to serving as one of the many volunteers needed to pull it all together. As was the case last year, hundreds of men who have never trusted Christ as Savior and Lord will be in attendance, providing us with a great opportunity to share the Gospel and shine the light of Christ. The date for the banquet is Thursday, March 5, at 5:30 p.m. See Don Norton, Eddie Watters or Wilburn Norton to see how you can be involved. The next opportunity will be a Rebuild Mission to Vidor, Texas April 5 - 11 a partnership with Nehemiah's Vision to rebuild homes and churches damaged or destroyed by recent storms.
