Peru 2020 Mission
 A team of PVSBC Mission Volunteers will depart on July 11 for a week of ministry among our Unreached People Group in Lahuaytambo, Peru. We will be teaching English through Bible Storying in the Lahuaytambo School and presenting the "Jesus Film" in the evenings. The total cost for the trip, including airfare, ground transportation, lodging and meals in Lahuaytambo is \$1200 per person. The first eight (8) people to turn in to Billy a completed international Missions Personal Information Form along with a \$300 deposit will make up this team. 
