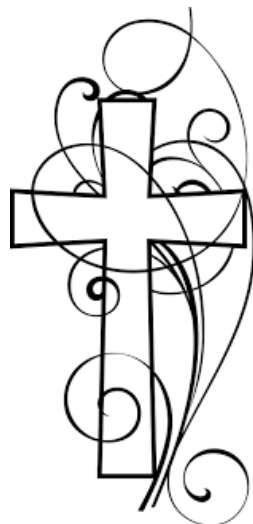

Missions and Outreach Ministry

I am excited to announce to you that I am planning an "Our Jerusalem" local missions event for October 12-15 this fall. Like last year, our focus will be to minister to our church members and others in our community by offering assistance with maintenance and repair projects around their homes. Last year, 25 PVS mission volunteers completed 14 projects which included lawn clean-up, gutter cleaning, pressure washing, fence repair, house cleaning, painting and installing light fixtures on the church campus, and a barn demolition. We also had a meal preparation team who provided delicious meals for all the volunteers. Please give me a call at (706)331-9661 to sign up for this year's Our Jerusalem Local Missions Week and/or to let me know of potential projects you would like to recommend for this year's event. I am also pleased to announce to you a mission trip to Israel scheduled for July 5-14, 2021. In partnership with P33 Adventures of Rome, we will be working with Pastor Israel Iluz and Congregation Kiryat Shemona, a Christian congregation in Northern Israel, sharing the Gospel throughout the city. There will also be daily trips to the various sites around Israel. The total cost for the trip will be \$3000, which includes round-trip airfare from Atlanta to Tel Aviv, hotel accommodations in Netanya, Kiryat Shemona, and Jerusalem, all ground transportation in Israel, plus morning and evening meals. A deposit of \$500 is due by October 15 and should be mailed to P33 Adventures, PO Box 129, Rome, GA 30162. Please give me a call if you have any questions.
