I'm glad to share with you ministries that you are supporting since I last wrote to you. I called Lisa, the director of Haven Health (our care pregnancy center). Because they could not do their annual fundraiser of Baby Bottle Boomerang, they are short on funds. They have furloughed three of five employees. Because we underspent our ministry budget due to Covid cancellations, we sent an additional \$5,000 to Haven Health.

The Community Kitchen of Rome feeds the homeless every day. Their donations are down. They can buy food in bulk cheaper than we may purchase it. We sent them a \$2,000 donation.

Billy Fricks led "Our Jerusalem" the week of October 11. He and volunteers from PVS built a handicap ramp, cut trees and shrubbery for some of our widows and installed other safety equipment for our people.

We also contracted with Ben Farrer and Chic-fil-A to provide meals for frontline healthcare workers. Dr. Kevin Hardwell accepted our request to provide lunch for the day-shift Floyd Medical ER employees. He also connected us with Kindred and the temporary hospital in their parking lot that treats only Covid patients. We were also privileged to provide lunches for Redmond Radiology and another office at Harbin Clinic. The box lunches contained a letter of appreciation from PVS signed by all our staff and we included gospel tracts.

Thank you for your faithful giving. We continue to fund our local, state, national and International missions commitments because of your generous spirit.
