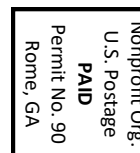

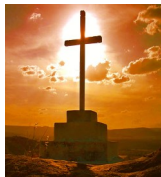
Things happening in August

As we begin preparing for a new school and church year, I'd like to review the Summer of '21. After the stagnancy of last year, this summer was a busy time for PVS kids! We had a tremendous time of fun and learning at Rocky Railway VBS (Trust Jesus!) and PVS Music Week. Both of these events were spiritual investments in the lives of children and their families.

Rocky Railway VBS was loads of fun with singing, dancing, games, and Bible-based lessons. We had approximately 120 children and over 100 adults to attend. The children also raised over \$1400 for the week's mission project! The main focus of every single moment of VBS week is to love kids and to remind them that God loves and cares for them. In fact, He cares so much He provided salvation through His Son, Jesus! Kids are still singing VBS songs!

Each year, PVS Music Week provides a day-camp atmosphere for children in our community. We capped our attendance at 60 children this year and had a waiting list of others who wanted to attend. PVS Music Week uses music, games, snacks, missions and even field trips as a means to reach children. It's not so much about the music and performance. There will always be missed notes, flubbed lines, and that one kid who sings off-key really loudly! And, that's ok. PVS Music Week is more about an investment. We might not live to see the dividends of these investments, but some day, these children will remember the songs they sang, the stories they heard, and the adults who spent time with them that week. They'll think about it as they raise their own children. And, it just might be the catalyst that brings them and their family to God and His church.
