From the Pastor's Desk

I hope you went online and read the summary of The Christian Index about the 2022 Southern Baptist Convention. There are lawsuits pending from victims of sexual abuse that was conducted by pastors, staff members and church members throughout our nation. Some of the incidents were reported to the S.B.C. and ignored. The S.B.C. has no authority over our churches. Individual churches are responsible for incidents in the local congregation. Many of the sex offenders left the church where they committed their crimes and went to serve other churches. Their criminal records were not made available through our convention and the individuals were not forthcoming with the next church.

Cooperative Program money has been used to pay for the investigation. Cooperative Program money is being employed to defend the S.B.C. and pay damages to victims. This is a heart breaking situation, especially for the victims.

I have talked with our deacons about how P.V.S. may give to ministries without going through the Nashville S.B.C. Headquarters. We will get credit for the Cooperative Program money given directly to S.B.C. Agencies. We will study the possibility of doing more locally, nationally and internationally with some of the Cooperative Program funds we have in our budget. That will allow us better accountability to know where the money is spent.

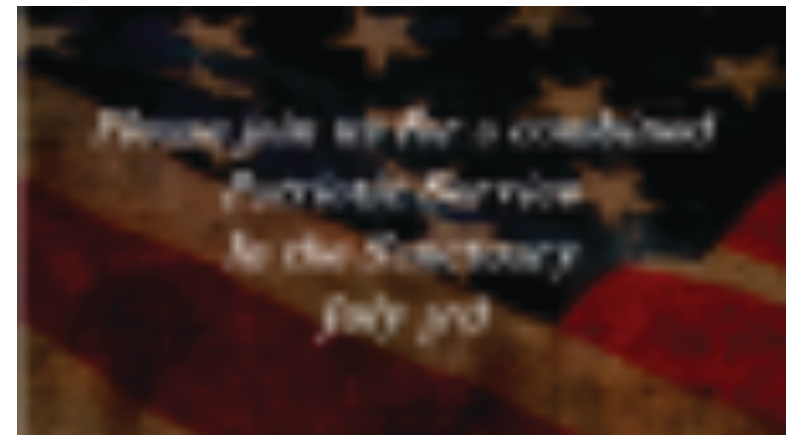
