Childcare

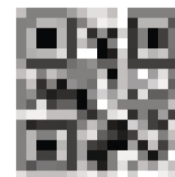

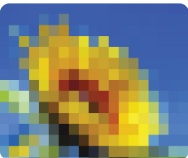

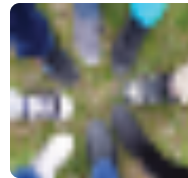
We can do better together.
