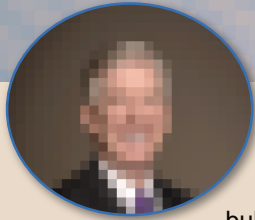

Childcare

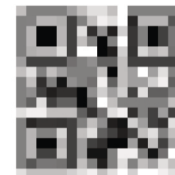

Orchestra rehearsal is every Sunday afternoon from 12:00-1:00 in the Worship Center.

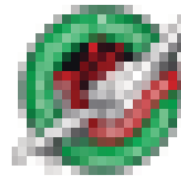


PrimeTimers Luncheon
