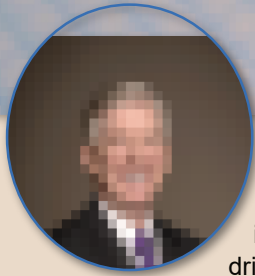

PrimeTimers Luncheon

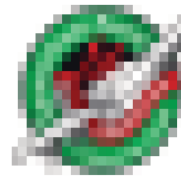
