From the Pastor's Desk

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, "Who is this?" The crowds answered, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee." Some of the same people who praised Jesus on His triumphal entry into Jerusalem later shouted insults at Him on the way to the Cross.

We've gathered to worship Jesus today. We need to be careful how we live out the Christian life. We praise Him here and sometimes we may not be very Christ-like with our behavior. We need to be consistent.

I was in a waiting room recently. Everybody in the room talked about the state of our country. I never said anything. I was studying two sermons and reading Daryl Strawberry's book. Several in the room were Christian. One man said, "I'm a believer, but I'm living with my girlfriend. I know it's wrong, but I'm doing it any way. I don't want people forcing their religion on me." Then he proceeded to talk (using profanity) about our society. When he left the room, he looked at one of the Christian ladies and said, "God bless you."

Let's be consistent with our profession of faith and be practicing Christians. If not, we are no better than those who called for Jesus death before Pilate.

We move toward "Good Friday". We cannot comprehend all Jesus did for us on the Cross. If we are going to point people to the Cross and salvation, our behavior has to match our beliefs.

Childcare

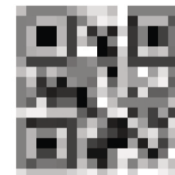
