

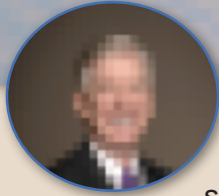

Student Fusion meets on Sunday mornings at 9 a.m. for Sunday School and Wednesday nights at 6 p.m.



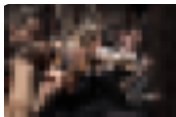
### Choir Rehearsal
