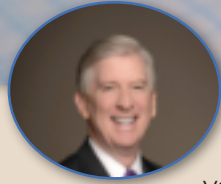

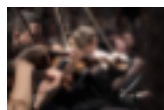
## Student Fusion

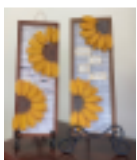
