

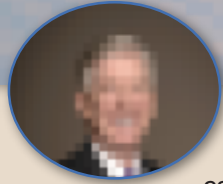

I was warned by an accountability friend "If you lead your church to get debt free, giving will decline." He was right! When I wrote this letter to you we were about \$200,000 behind on our budget giving to date.

I have never written a message like this to you. Tithing is not a suggestion, but a requirement from God. If you desire to continue ministry on the level God led us to achieve, we have to obey God and give.

The choice is in your hands. Our staff is exercising caution to spend less than you give!

The choir will meet at 7:15 p.m. on Wednesdays after Wednesday night service.



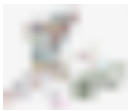
Orchestra Rehearsal
