

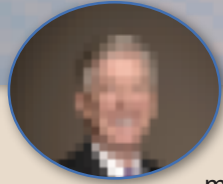

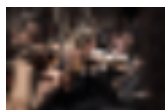
### Student Fusion

Student Fusion meets on Sunday mornings at 9AM for Sunday School and Wednesday nights at 6PM.



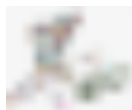
### Choir Rehearsal

This program provides Christmas gifts that are purchased, wrapped, and delivered by PVS volunteers to over 100 children in Floyd County.

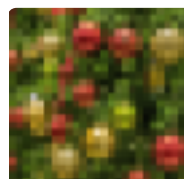
Angels are available in the main welcome center.
