No skills necessary. Anybody can help! Tasks include storm cleanup, mud-outs, construction, or just being a helper.

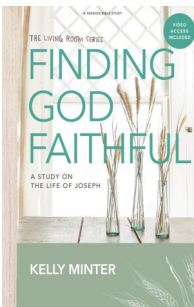

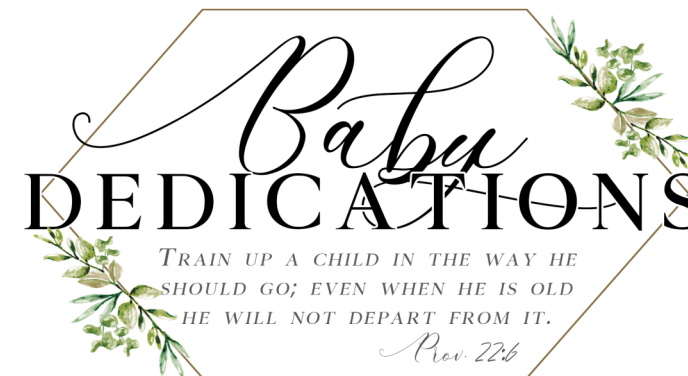
