- Flip-flops/Crocs
- FOUR outfits suitable for cold mountain weather
- plenty of underclothes (at least one extra of each type)
- modest sleeping attire
- wet weather gear (poncho, raincoat, cap)
- 2 kitchen-sized trash bags (to put back in your suitcase filled with your dirty clothes (they must travel home inside your bag)
- Power strip (at least one person per bedroom)
- Phone charger & accessories

OPTIONAL, BUT RECOMMENDED:

- extra money for conference merch & souvenirs
- Chapstick/lotion for windburn if you plan to take advantage of the outdoors free time options
- Card games & other compact games to play with friends

COMFORT TIP:

Dress in layers each day. A shirt under a sweater/hoodie allows you to stay warmer outside and remove a layer inside if you get hot.

LODGE EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Live by the "big three."
- 2. Stay out of any bedroom/bathroom that is not your own.
- 3. Stay out of the kitchen except for meal/snack times.
- 4. Pajamas are NOT acceptable in public areas in the lodge.
- 5.Use only your room bathroom to get ready. Half baths in common areas are for #1 and #2 only.
- 6.Do not touch the property of anyone else.
- 7. Stay out of the personal space of others.
- 8. Lights out means turn off the lights and rest. Earbuds and personal electronics are fine, as long as you do not disturb your roommates.
- 9.If you use the hot tub, do NOT put soap or shampoo in it. It will destroy the motor and your family will be charged to replace it.
- 10. Public areas of the lodge are closed during Lights Out hours up until the published time for breakfast.
