Since 1987, this Association has been actively involved in conference ministries throughout the United States.

STS Camp targets students from sixth grade through seniors in high school. Due to insurance regulations, it is STS's policy to require each person to be in the sixth grade.

We will have 1 counselor per 3 high schoolers of the same sex, and 1 counselor per 5 middle schoolers of the same sex. We do not have additional space or funding for extra adults. And, STS Camp does not anyone to attend who is under the sixth grade. Regular youth workers will receive first preference, parents second preference, and active church members over the age of 21 third preference. All counselors must be background-checked and trained by our church's online child safety materials.
